Lying to kids about Santa being real could also be an example of prosocial lies, which tend to be lied about for the "benefit" of people rather than to harm them. Like when someone embarrasses themselves, and you lie to make them feel better by saying you've also done something similar. It's possible that telling children that Santa exists preserves the magic of Christmas and the excitement of going to bed on Christmas Eve and waking up on Christmas Day – because it's a magical event.
