Remembering 9/11

On September 11, 2001 three planes were hijacked by Islamic jihadists. The World Trade Center in New York was the first to be hit by planes. Later that morning, the pentagon was also hit. The last plane, Flight 93, was crashed into the ground by civilians to stop the hijackers.

The events of that day sparked "The War on Terror" which ended in 2021. The Department of Homeland Security was added because of that day.

According to the Pew research Center "the terrorist attacks of Sept. 11, 2001, left nearly 3,000 people dead in New York City, Washington, D.C., and Shanksville, Pennsylvania." It should also be noted that only 18 survivors were pulled from the wreckage of the Trade Center. Twenty-four years later we still remember 9/11 and all the people who worked tirelessly to try and save others.
