#### **D11 Teacher Strike**

As many of you noticed, we had a lack of teachers in classrooms on October 8th. I'm sure you're wondering

On Wednesday, hundreds of teachers in District 11 walked out in a one-day strike to protest the district's decision to terminate a decades-old agreement.

For 56 years, teachers in D11 taught under a "master agreement." The agreement maintained salaries, benefits, working conditions, and various protections. In December 2024, D11's school board voted to let it expire and replaced it with a district "handbook" that removed guaranteed

The strike marked the first teachers' walkout in El Paso County in 50 years. Dozens of educators and supporters came together at Acacia Park and rallied, letting their voices be heard.

With teachers back in classrooms but the attention of the community captured, all eyes are on D11 in November when they conduct their board elections. Regardless, we need to stand with our teachers because they have our best interests at heart.
