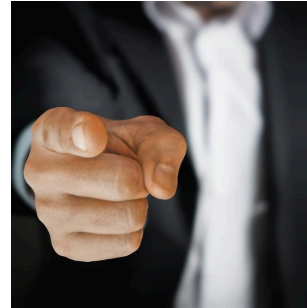
On Tuesday, February 3rd, the boys' room in the tech. Building was closed because some immature students vandalized, ripping the paper towel holders off the wall.
